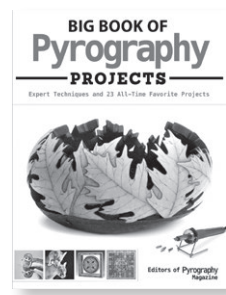

1. Draw the design. Select a pattern and copy it onto the bangle using graphite transfer paper. Or, draw a freehand design onto the bangle.

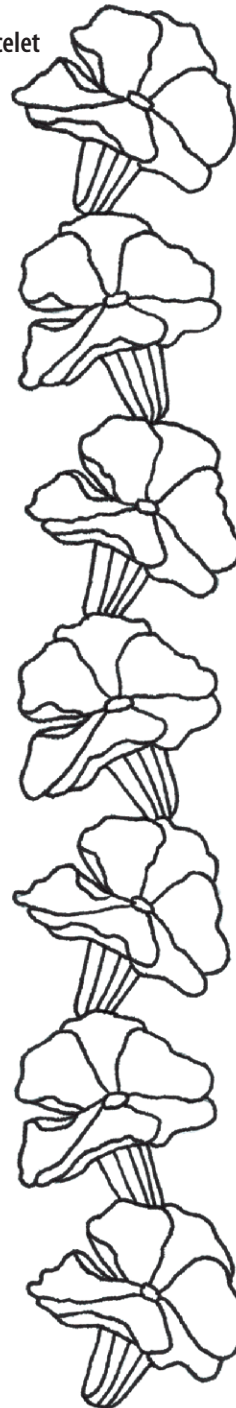


2. Burn the outline. Use a writing, skew, or spear tip to outline the design. Keep a firm hold on the bangle but keep the hot tip away from your fingers. When you have finished the outline, erase any remaining pencil marks.



3. Detail or shade the design. Fill in the outline with texture and accent it with shading. If desired, use stamp tips to further decorate the bangle, incorporate a name into the design, or paint the bangle when you're done burning it.

### Materials:

- Wooden bangle
- Sandpaper: 180- or 220-grit
- Graphite transfer paper
- Paste wax

### Tools:

- Pyrography machine and tips/pens: writing, skew, or spear; shading; assorted
- Pencil
- Artist's eraser
- Soft cloths

### Finishing the Bangle

When you are done burning the design, use a soft cloth to rub paste wax over the entire surface of the bangle. Use a dry cloth to buff the wax to a shine. Your bangle is ready to wear and enjoy.
